My latest project is an educational children's book turned app for iPad: *World of Animals – What's It Called?* (available on the iTunes App store). I was involved in the concept and design, did all the text, and hired and managed professionals to do the illustrations, animations, IOS development, voice-over, and background music. I also selected and edited the included animal sounds.

I have two books traditionally published: *Backroads of Utah* (Voyageur Press), *Hobby Farming for Dummies* (Wiley)

I was a regular contributor a local newspaper for several years; contributing articles and photos on mountain activities (snowsports, hiking and biking...) I have contributed articles and graphics for other various publications (for both print and web) on travel, photography and crafts. I developed CBTs on HTML, Perl, and NXI's communications software, and presented sessions on Perl, web scripting, Novell's web options, and WebSphere.
